Bush Roses

Absolutely Fabulous (S)	FI	Butter- Yellow upright rose. Strong anise-liquorice fragrance. Old fashioned bloom form. Prolific, continuous flowering. Medium glossy foliage. (Winter)
Aotearoa NZ (S)	HT	Delightful large, soft, creamy pink blooms with a powerful fragrance and dark glossy foliage. (Winter)
Attention Seeker (G)	HT	Rich golden apricot blooms that catch the eye. Highly fragrant blooms on long stems. (Winter/Spring)
Auckland Metro (S)	HT	Creamy white fragrant flowers displayed on a healthy bush. (Winter)
Best Friend (G)	HT	Very fragrant, double flowers of unusual deep, glowing pink. Strong, sweet fragrance with repeated flowering through the season. Upright growth with large, light green foliage. (Spring)
Blackberry Nip (G)	HT	Deep unfading purple blooms with a stunning old-fashioned fragrance. (Winter/Spring)
Blue Moon (S)	HT	Large (10cm), fully double, lavender flowers packed with petals. Strongly fragrant. (Winter)
Celebration (S)	HT	Large blooms of pearl pink. A vigorous plant with good foliage and award-winning scent. (Winter)
Champagne Breakfast (G) Fl		Soft golden peach blooms, very unusual and very beautiful. (Winter/Spring)
Christchurch Remembers (G) Fl		Medium red blooms darkening on the outer edges surrounded by mid green foliage. This rose is a multiple award winner. (Winter/Spring)

City of Lights (G)	FI	The most pleasant, sweet citrus fragrance which can be smelt from metres away. The bush has a compact growth habit with dark glossy foliage. (Spring)
Dame Te Ata (G)	Shrub	Named after the late Māori Queen, this rose covers itself with deep purple blooms with an unforgettable fragrance. A nice compact plant for the front of the garden. (Winter/Spring)
Deep Secret (S)	HT	Very deep velvety dark black-red blooms with an intense fragrance. (Winter)
Diamond Design (G)	ΗT	Traditional style HT blooms with a kiss of pink of the petal tips on a medium sized bush. With an Esmeralda, Paddy Stephens and Elina in its breading it makes for a stunning rose. Winner of the Certificate of Merit at Palmerston North International Trial Ground 2010 and Winner of the New Zealand Rose Industry Gold Award 2012. (Spring)
Double Delight (S)	HT	This is a terrific rose with extremely fragrant, very large creamy white blooms blushed with strawberry red. No two flowers are the same. (Winter)
Elina (G)	HT	Large well-formed creamy-yellow flowers on long stems making it great for picking. (Winter/Spring)
Endless Summer (G)	HT	NEW RELEASE Stunning yellow flowers which holds its colour well. Perfect for picking and has great disease resistance. (Spring)
Ever Lasting Hope (G)	SHRUB	Named for Postnatal Depression Canterbury. Large medium pink flower, extremely fragrant. Tall, slightly spreading bush with dark glossy foliage. (Spring)
Feeling Better (G)	FI	Bred as a follow-up to Looking Good for the Look Good Feel Better promotion, Feeling Better has soft cream blooms with a thin raspberry red edge. The cream petals turn pink with age making the older flowers stunning in their own right. Excellent health. (Spring)

Fire Ball (G)	FI	Vermillion orange blooms with a soft yellow centre. Medium sized flowers which bloom in clusters. It is a healthy rose with a pleasant fragrance. This rose won the Gold Star of the South Pacific in 2015. (Spring)
Friesia (S)	FI	Bright shining yellow with strong spicy fragrance. Compact plant. (Winter)
Ginger Crunch (G)	FI	NEW RELEASE This striking rose has a unique burnt orange/terracotta colour. Masses of flowers are clustered onto each stem and the buds are tightly curled pops of colour. (Winter/Spring)
Glorious (S)	ΗT	Superbly healthy, glossy green foliage complemented by simply 'Glorious' large yellow blooms. Fragrant, easy care. Perfect for picking. (Winter)
Grandmas Rose (G)	FI	Highly fragrant deep purple/red blooms matched with a dark green glossy foliage. Perfect rose for any grandmother. (Winter/Spring)
Green With Envy (G)	FI	Winner of the Public Choice Award in Palmerston North, this new green rose is a great conversation piece. Green with Envy has large heads on long stems which makes it great for picking. It lasts very well in a vase and the rose colour intensifies as it ages! (Winter/Spring)
Hamilton Gardens (S/G)	HT	A sport of Paddy Stephens, this rose has all the bush attributes of its parent with beautiful cream and apricot blooms. (Winter/Spring)
Hans Christian Andersen	i (G) Fl	A stunning plant that smothers itself with a cascade of dark red blooms. (Spring)
Hayley Westenra (S)	HT	Fragrant cream peach blooms that repeat well on a medium height bush. (Winter)
High Ho Silver (G)	HT	Double siler lilac blooms with a powerful fragrance that repeats well on a nicely balance bush. (Winter/Spring)

Honey Bun (G)	ΗT	NEW RELEASE Large old fashioned style blooms that come one to a stem. Soft creamy-peach hue. Excellent for picking, with a light fragrance. The robust plant has glossy foliage. (Winter/Spring)
Hot Topic (G)	FI	Small clusters of pure rich orange blooms that age to apricot. The frilly blooms have a glorious fruity fragrance. The bush is of medium height with dark semi glossy foliage. (Spring)
lceberg (G)	FI	Crisp white blooms smother this well-known bush. Free flowering. (Winter/Spring)
Ingrid Bergman (S)	HT	An old favourite Hybrid Tea red rose this is ideal for picking with good health. (Winter)
Ink Spots (G)	FI	Extremely floriferous in full bloom you can hardly see the foliage for flowers. The flowers are white with a burgundy centre which turns more purple with age. (Winter/Spring)
Jack Frost (G)	FI	Clusters of showy white blooms. Buds can have a slight pink blush in cooler weather. Very dark glassy foliage. The bush has a slightly spreading habit and is extremely healthy. (Spring)
Just Joey (S)	ΗT	The large richly scented flowers are a blend of coppery shades with apricot. (Winter)
Kathryn Morley (S)	Eng	Continuous blooms of softest pink with a delicate fruity fragrance will delight you through-out the summer. The flowers are double and cupped. (Winter)
Lemon n Lime (G)	FI	An exciting floribunda rose that has blooms of lemon with green tinges, really the name says it all! Dark glossy foliage and very healthy. Multi Award Winner. (Winter/Spring)
Little Miss Perfect (G)	FI	Lovely compact (60cm) healthy plant, with blooms of coral that smother the plant consistently, this is an eye-catching conversation piece for any garden. (Winter/Spring)

Looking Good (G)	FI	This rose was named to highlight the work done by the "Look Good Feel Better 'foundation who do fantastic work with post cancer treatment. Its showy two-toned pink blooms smother the bush in large clusters. Looking Good has very dark glossy foliage, good health and is a tall grower. (Spring)
Love Bug (G)	FI	Dark cardinal red blooms forming clusters contrast beautifully with the dark, very glossy foliage. It has a subtle fragrance and good disease resistance. Won the Gold Star of the South Pacific 2017. (Spring)
Love Heart (G)	ΗT	Vibrant crimson blooms on exceptionally long stems – great for the vase. (Spring)
Love Me Do (G)	ΗT	Lovely cream fragranced blooms on a bush of glossy dark foliage. (Spring)
Loving Memory (G)	ΗT	Large well-formed glowing red blooms on a strong healthy bush. (Spring)
Magnifi-Scent (G)	ΗT	This Canadian bred rose has extremely fragrant crimson blooms that are very fast repeating. The bush plant is covered with glossy disease resistant foliage. (Spring)
Margaret Merrill (G)	FI	Pearly white high centred blooms with an alluring perfume. (Winter/Spring)
Mulberry Wine (G)	FI	Smaller compact floribunda, very healthy award-winning rose, fragrant. (Winter/Spring)
Mulberry Wine (G) My Mum (S)	FI	

Old Friends (G)	FI	A soft halo of creamy petals surround the lemon centre of this outstanding rose. The petals are large and full and the flowers are collected in clusters for a fresh pale lemon effect. (Winter/Spring)
Otago University (G)	HT	Released to celebrate the University of Otago's 150 th year. Vibrant yellow Hybrid Tea blooms complemented by mid green glossy foliage. (Spring)
Paddy Stephens (G)	HT	Beautiful coral-orange blooms with salmon hints complement glossy dark foliage. Free flowering. (Winter/Spring)
Peace (S)	HT	Large, high centred flowers, blending yellow and pale pink. Long lasting blooms with a light fragrance. (Winter)
Perfume Delight (S)	HT	Very, very fragrant with nicely shaped blooms in vivid deep pink. Glossy Foliage. Blooms in flushes throughout the season. (Winter)
Pride of Palmy (G)	ΗT	Bright showy yellow blows with a faint orange outer margin to the petals. Lovely glossy dark green foliage and a great rose for picking. An eye-catching rose. (Spring)
Radio Times (S)	Eng	Repeat flowering. The flowers, beautifully formed, are of the freshest pink colouring imaginable. Strong Old Rose fragrance. Arching growth. (Winter)
Remember Me (S)	ΗT	A blend of burnt orange and apricot blooms complemented by very glossy foliage. (Winter)
Rhapsody In Blue (S)	FI	Clusters of plum blooms that fade to a slate blue. (Winter)
Royal Dane (G)	HT	Well shaped burnt orange blooms with a strong fragrance. (Spring)
Scent to Remember (G)	FI	Delicious smell from exquisite, peachy apricot coloured blooms and is seldom without a flower from spring to autumn. (Winter/Spring)

Scott Base (G)	FI	Award winning rose of white very fragrant blooms on a compact but vigorous bush. (Spring)
Serendipity (G)	FI	A stunning display of colourfast yellow blooms. Very healthy, with striking foliage. (Winter/Spring)
Sexy Rexy (G)	FI	Large clusters of soft pink, rosette-shaped blooms. A compact bush. (Spring)
Shangri-la (G)	FI	Masses of well-formed shell pink blooms which produce medium sized clusters. The glossy green foliage compliments them well. (Spring)
Smart Choice (G)	HT	A large, flowered Hybrid Tea with lots of rich pink, long lasting blooms. (Winter/Spring)
Smitten (G)	FI	NEW RELEASE Delicate shades of cream and shell pink, this rose has a gorgeous ruffled shape with a deeper pink on the reverse of the petals. Health dark green foliage set off these beautiful blooms.
Strawberry Blonde (G)	FI	Masses of fragrant golden apricot blooms that soften with age. Extremely dark, healthy foliage with a compact growth habit. Winner of Certificate of Merit 2017 at Palmerston North International Trial, and Children's Choice Award 2018 plus Best NX Bred Rose 2018 at Hamilton Gardens. (Spring)
Tabasco (G)	ΗT	This rose is stopping people in their tracks to have a look. Certificate of Merit at Palmerston North Trial Ground, Tabasco has medium-large orange-salmon blooms produced both singly and in substantial clusters. A medium height bush of upright growth habit and with good disease resistance. (Spring)
Tequila Sunrise (G)	FI	Long lasting deep yellow blooms tipped with orange red on a medium sized plant. (Spring)
Truly Special (G)	FI	Truly Special is truly special to Rob Somerfield, who bred this and presented it to his parents on their 60th wedding anniversary. The blossoms are rose pink with a slight warm glow in the centre of the flower. It opens to an old-fashioned form and has many petals. It has

		an amazing fragrance. The plant is small, compact, and very healthy. This is a variety that is great for picking. (Spring)
Trumpeter (G)	FI	Masses of luminous red blooms on compact plant. (Spring)
Valentine Heart (G)	FI	Lovely pink floribunda with a scalloped edge to the petals. Very free flowering and this rose looks stunning planted in groups. (Spring)
White Romance (G)	FI	Extremely healthy with a nice rounded compact habit, the bush smothers itself with stunning pure white blooms complemented by rich dark glossy green foliage. This rose should rival lceberg. (Winter/Spring)

Climbing Roses

All My Love (G)	Soft pink blooms. Shorter growing climber. This rose is very healthy and floriferous. (Spring)
Climbing Blackberry Nip (G)	A vigorous climbing version of the Blackberry Nip, same purple blooms. Fragrant. (Winer/Spring)
Compassion (G)	Vigorous climber with well-formed fragrant pink apricot blooms. (Winter/Spring)
Crepuscule (G)	Rambler. Attractive flowers of orange and apricot. (Winter)
Double Fragrance (G)	Stunning dark red blooms and a delightfully powerful fragrance! (Spring)
Dublin Bay (G)	Deep brilliant red blooms smother this great old climber. (Winter/Spring)
Effervescence (G)	Rich cream blooms complemented by dark glossy foliage. Has very few thorns. (Spring)
lceberg Climber (G)	Smothered with crisp white blooms this makes a great display in the garden. (Winter/Spring)

Kaimai Sunset (G)	Rustic copper buds opening terracotta – very free flowering. (Spring)
Pierre De Ronsard (G)	Large full blooms that look like little round cabbages but oh so much prettier. The flowers are creamy white with over tones of lavender pink. Nice fragrance. Strong vigorous grower with bright green generous foliage. (Spring)
Sally Holmes (G)	Fragrant, large single, creamy white blooms, repeats well on a tall very healthy plant that performs equally well as a shrub or climber. (Winter/Spring)
Sir Edmund Hillary (S)	Highly scented flowers of beautiful form open to a blend of pure white with golden centres. Healthy medium green and glossy foliage and strong growth to about 4m. (Winter)
Spellbound (G)	A good healthy climber, stunning in fall bloom and award winning. (Spring)
Tropical Essence (G)	Large well-formed peach blooms on long stems with an amazing sweet tropical fragrance. Compact habit for a climber, dark foliage and good health. (Spring)
Uetersen (G)	Large clusters of fragrant deep pink blooms on an extremely healthy plant. (Spring)
Zepherine Drouhin (S)	The blooms are Cerise-Pink coloured. Canes are unique, flexible and burgundy coloured. Virtually thornless. Lovely old rose perfumed. (Winter)

Standard Roses (80cm Stem)

- Attention Seeker (G) NEW RELEASE Vigorous medium growing upright plant with nice glossy foiliage. These striking golden-apricot blooms are ' a stand out in the garden. Produced in clusters, the blooms have a pleasing light scent. (Winter/Spring)
- Blackberry Nip (G)An excellent rose with healthy disease resistant foliage, seductively scented,long stemmed, deep purple blooms that are perfect to pick. (Spring/Winter)

Christchurch Remembers	(G) Medium red blooms which darken on the outer edges surrounded by mid green foliage. (Winter/Spring)
Diamond Design (G)	Traditional style creamy white HT blooms with a kiss of pink at the petal tips. (Winter/Spring)
Feeling Better (G)	Soft cream blooms with a thin raspberry red edge. The cream petals turn pink with age making the older flowers stunning in their own right. (Spring)
Grandma's Rose (G)	Highly fragrant deep purple/red blooms matched with dark green glossy foliage. Perfect rose for any grandmother. (Winter/Spring)
lceberg (G)	Crisp white blooms smother this well-known bush. (Winter/Spring)
Julie Margurite (G)	NEW RELEASE Delicate soft pink buds open to creamy pink flowers that fade to almost white as they mature. An abundance of fragrant blooms are complemented by deep, glossy, green leaves with good disease resistance. Compact and slightly spreading bush. (Spring)
Lemon n Lime (G)	A Floribunda rose with soft lemon blooms with green tinges. (Winter/Spring)
Love Me Do (G)	NEW RELEASE The ivory white blooms open to reveal soft peach centres. Flowers appear with generous abundance and carry an intense sweet fragrance. There is no doubt that you will indeed 'love me do'. Healthy glossy green foliage is an added bonus. (Spring)
Loving Memory (G)	Large well-formed lightly scented blooms of cherry red on long stems which make it great for cutting. (Winter/Spring)
Margaret Merrill (G)	Pearly white high centred blooms with an alluring perfume. (Winter/Spring)
Night Light (G)	Blooms are lemon yellow with the outer petals ageing to cream. (Spring)
Serendipity (G)	A fantastic healthy rose with bright, clear yellow blooms which are produced in abundance. Wonderful fragrance and excellent disease resistant foliage. (Winter/Spring)
Truly Special (G)	A compact rose with medium pink blooms that present themselves in a symmetrical old-fashioned style. Highly fragrant and great for picking as the

	blooms tend to come one to a stem. Dark glossy foliage sets these rose blooms off perfectly. Named in honour of Rob Somerfield's parent's 60 th wedding anniversary. (Spring)
Trumpeter (G)	A neat, compact rose with dense green, glossy foliage. Free-flowering with clusters of rounded buds that open to fully double, rich orange-red blooms with a gentle fragrance. (Winter/Spring)
White Romance (G)	Stunning pure white blooms complemented by rich dark glossy green foliage. (Winter/Spring)

Standard Patio Roses (45cm Stem)

Centurion (G)	NEW RELEASE A stunning scarlet red that covers the bush throughout the season. Good disease resistance on glossy green leaves. (Spring)
Fireball (G)	Showy orange blooms with a white reverse. The masses of blooms form large clusters on a long stem and have an appealing fragrance. (Spring)
Grandma's Rose (G)	NEW RELEASE This rose clothes itself with stunningly beautiful red-purple flowers that open into an old fashioned style. The dark green glossy foliage compliments the blooms well and it is a highly fragrant variety. (Spring)
Green with Envy (G)	Long lasting buds that have a touch of pink and open to gorgeous green blooms. Flowers last long on the bush and in a vase. (Spring)
lceberg (G)	Crisp white blooms smother this well-known bush. (Spring)
Ink Spots (G)	This is a Prica Hybrid that absolutely smothers itself with white blooms that have a burgundy purple eye. It has good health and very floriferous. (Spring)
Little Miss Perfect (G)	Lovely compact healthy plant, with blooms of coral that smother the plant consistently. (Spring)
Mulberry Wine (G)	NEW RELEASE A beautiful blend of purple and cerise blooms that will steal the show in the garden. Very fragrant and repeat flowering blooms from summer to autumn, very healthy award winning rose. (Spring)

Purple Pizzazz (G)	Purple-cerise patio rose with a silvery white reverse that softens to a purple lavender with age. A strong sweet perfume. (Spring)
Scott Base (G)	AWARD WINNER. White very fragrant blooms on a compact but vigorous bush. (Spring)
Truly Special (G)	A compact rose with medium pink blooms that present themselves in a symmetrical old-fashioned style. Highly fragrant and great for picking as the blooms tend to come one to a stem. Dark glossy foliage sets these rose blooms off perfectly. Named in honour of Rob Somerville's parents 60th wedding anniversary. (Spring)
Trumpeter (G)	Masses of luminous red blooms on compact plant. (Spring)
White Romance (G)	Large white blooms against dark green glossy foliage. (Spring)
